CHAMPAGNE

1. **Moutardier Brut** 29.95
Clean, refreshing and full of citrus fruit with a smooth biscuity finish.
2. **Taittinger Brut Reserve** 39.95
Dry, supple and elegant style. Quite intense ripe fruit; structured, fresh and long. A cut above most non-vintage.
3. **Veuve Clicquot Vintage Reserve 1999** 65.95
Decidedly rich and full bodied with a floral bouquet and lightly fruity, biscuity flavour. Balanced and age worthy.
4. **Cuvée Dom Perignon 1999** 135.95
Consistently superb, becoming fine and toasty in bouquet with a gentle richness, biscuity and complex in flavour. An excellent vintage.
5. **Krug Grand Cuvée** 129.95
Dry with an elegant, floral, biscuity bouquet but with extraordinary richness, depth and class. Harmonious with tremendous length.
6. **Louis Roederer Cristal 1999** 295.95
Dry, relatively light with more floral notes to the bouquet. Becomes nuttied and honeyed with age. Has a subtle silkiness and lingering finish.

CHAMPAGNE MAGNUM

7. **Veuve Clicquot Brut Yellow Label** 85.95
Full, fruity style, citrus, quite rich but rounded and balanced with good length of flavour.

PINK CHAMPAGNE

8. **Moutardier Prestige Brut Rosé** 29.95
Clean floral aromas and a distinctly fruity character from this small estate growers' champagne.

SPARKLING WINE

9. **Pelorus Cloudy Bay, New Zealand** 22.95
Medium bodied, elegant style of New World sparkler with clean and pure apple and citrus fruit. A touch of subtle bready yeastiness adds complexity.

WHITE WINE

FRANCE, ALSACE

10. Trimbach Riesling 2004 22.95

Dry, very long-lived with remarkably complex, powerful perfume and flavour. Flinty, mineral, petrolly, very long and rich.

11. Trimbach Gewürztraminer 2004 24.95

Highly aromatic, dry, spicy, elegant style with some grapefruit and floral elements. Balanced and medium bodied.

FRANCE, BURGUNDY

12. Chablis Domaine des Manants 2005 21.95

Light and dry with flinty, mineral notes, subtle plum fruit, good definition and some complexity.

**13. Chablis Premier Cru Fourchame
Domaine Gerard Duplessis 2000** 31.95

Rich and luscious, complex with great mineral finesse and beautiful balance

14. Pouilly Fuisse, Les Vieux Murs, Loren et Fils 2004 31.95

An elegant, pure chardonnay that is dry and luscious with much finesse.

15. Puligny Montrachet Jean Marc Pillot 2004 45.95

Elegant, oaky dry white. Well-balanced with nutty, creamy and toasty characters.

16. Meursault Les Vireuils Domaine Dupont Fahn 2004 47.95

Renowned for its nutty, buttery fruit, sometimes lusciously peachy; the standard of wine from this producer is always elegant and enticing with layer upon layer of flavour on the finish.

FRANCE, LOIRE VALLEY

17. Sancerre Domaine Daulny 2006 24.95

Quite pungent aroma, grassy, asparagus characters, full, round flavour, evolves quite quickly.

18. Pouilly Fumé Serge Seguin Père et Fils 2005 22.95

Fresh and lively with citrus and gooseberry fruit and the typical gunflint minerality which typifies Pouilly Fumé.

GERMANY, MOSEL

- 19. Weingut Freiherr von Heddesdorf Winninger Riesling Kabinett 2003** 24.95

Elegant, minerally and slatey bouquet of ripe fruit. On the palate its off-dry full fruit flavour of pears and lychees is beautifully balanced by the steely acidity typical of the Winnigen Uhlen area.

ITALY

- 20. Pinot Grigio, Duetorri, Trentino 2005** 24.95

Full bodied, concentrated with ripe pear, spice and quince notes. Deep and appley in the mouth with excellent structure and length.

- 21. Salviano, Orvieto Classico 2005** 21.95

Aromatic with a real depth of fruit flavour balanced by a nice crisp acidity.

CHILE

- 22. Vicuna Sauvignon Semillon, Central Valley 2006** 17.95

A vivacious character full of fresh fruit and lemon zest with delicious harmony and length.

- 23. Palena Chardonnay, Central Valley 2005** 18.95

Mellow, rich chardonnay full of fresh ripe fruit flavours and a hint of vanilla.

- 24. Palena Sauvignon Blanc Reserva, Central Valley 2006** 18.95

Aromas of tropical fruits mixed with freshly mown grass! It's packed with fresh crisp melon and mango fruit flavours with a lovely herby, crisp character.

USA, CALIFORNIA

- 25. Wattle Creek Sauvignon Blanc, Mendocino County 2003** 29.95

Vibrant aromas of lemon and lime. Delicious ripe Sauvignon fruit, shows on the palate with a long, lingering finish.

- 26. Bonny Doon Ca' del Solo Malvasia Bianca, Monterey 2005** 24.95

Made from Malvasia Bianco, the grape of Madeira, this is a delicious dry unoaked white packed full of exotic floral character, strongly redolent of jasmine and lychee.

AUSTRALIA

27. Old Broke Block Semillon, Hunter Valley 2005 21.95

Delicious nose of candied zesty lemon. Medium bodied, but filled to the brim with lemon and crisp, juicy pear fruit with a hint of honey on the finish. At 10.5% abv it's a great lunchtime wine.

28. Four Sisters Sauvignon Blanc, McLaren Vale 2005 21.95

Aromatic and herby on the nose with punchy aromatic and rich fruit flavours.

29. Sunny Cliff Chardonnay, New South Wales 2006 22.95

Ripe peach and fruit flavours are augmented by some vanilla and oak. Moderately high in alcohol with some fruit sweetness and warmth on the finish.

NEW ZEALAND

30. Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough 2006 39.95

Staggered picking provides an array of flavours from blackcurrant leaf to tropical fruit. Nuanced, finely balanced with pungency of aroma and purity of flavour, and persistence on the palate.

31. McCorkindale Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough 2006 23.95

Zesty, aromatic wine with gooseberry and passion fruit flavours.

32. McCorkindale Chardonnay, Waipara Valley 2004 26.95

Warm and full bodied with flavours of melon and white peach; hints of crystallised citrus peel, grilled hazelnuts and subtle oak.

SOUTH AFRICA

33. Montestell Chenin Blanc, Paarl 2006 17.95

Dry and crisp wine, enhanced by a medley of tropical flavours that linger in the mouth.

34. Quoin Rock Sauvignon Blanc, Western Cape 2003 26.95

Subtle floral nose with lots of herbs and cut grass. Racy, fresh apple and gooseberry fruit flavours and a long mineral finish.

ARGENTINA

35. Santa Julia Pinot Grigio, Mendoza 2005 17.95

Soft and grassy in style with subtle hints of gooseberries. Discreet fruitiness and a complex rich flavour.

ENGLAND

36. Three Choirs, Gloucestershire 2005 18.95

Markedly herbaceous style, full bodied and with good length.
Pungent,characterful, well structured, dry wine with great finesse.

PINK WINE

37. Pinot Grigio Ca'Solare, Italy 2006 16.95

Fresh, clean nose with aromas of green apples, peaches and flowers.
Soft white fruit flavours are full and rounded on the palate.

38. Chateau du Panery Cotes du Rhone 2005 17.95

Attractive, deep pink colour with an expressive nose showing raspberry
and red currant aromas, Delicate yet rich with freshness on the palate

39. Sancerre Rosé Domaine Daniel Chotard 2006 24.95

Piercingly fresh acidity with a clean fresh floral nose and full ripe lemon
flavour followed by a long dry finish with hints of vanilla. Huge length
and full mouthfeel.

RED WINE

AUSTRALIA

40. Mitchell's Peppertree Shiraz, Clare Valley 2004 26.95
Rich, spicy berry and liquorice aromas and flavours are hallmarks of the style underpinned by ripe tannins. Good concentration and weight.

41. Mitchell's Grenache Sangiovese Mourvedre, Clare Valley 2002 24.95
Ripe, sweet, slightly spicy fruit in a medium to full bodied style. Concentrated with ample ripe tannins and good depth and length.

NEW ZEALAND

42. CJ Pask Cabernet Merlot Malbec, Hawkes Bay 2004 26.95
Aromas of plum, spice and sweet oak. This soft juicy, plummy Merlot is supported by sweet, subtle oak flavours

43. McCorkindale Pinot Noir, Waipara Valley 2006 34.95
Supple and elegant; aromatic with strong plum, black cherry, blackberry, liquorice and smoky oak flavours.

SOUTH AFRICA

44. The Ruins Pinotage, Robertson 2006 18.95
This has a fantastic stylish aroma of ripe red fruits, with a layer of smokiness. To taste it's silky and balanced with all that red fruit coming through and a gorgeous touch of vanilla.

45. Brampton Old Vines, Stellenbosch 2004 21.95
Aromas of blackberries and plums follow through to a richly spiced palate, with chocolate and mocha adding complexity to the long finish.

USA, CALIFORNIA

46. Opus One, Napa Valley 1999 163.50
Fine, complex oak and blackcurrant dominated bouquet with a mineral quality. Powerful, concentrated, and high tannin – delicacy and finesse with age.

- 47. Frogs Leap Zinfandel, Napa Valley 2003** 39.95
Medium to full bodied with fine spicy dark berry and black cherry fruit. Great depth, richness and firm with even tannins.

CHILE

- 48. Concha y Toro Merlot, Central Valley 2005** 19.95
White pepper and chocolate, plenty of rich sweet plum and cherry fruit given structure by a hint of oak. Long and full finish.

- 49. Valdivieso Single Vineyard Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon 2005** 28.95
An excellent well-balanced Chilean Cabernet with cassis and black cherry fruit spiced with notes of cinnamon, vanilla and mocha coffee. Full-bodied with silky tannins and fresh acidity on the finish.

ARGENTINA

- 50. Santa Julia Malbec, Mendoza 2006** 18.95
All smoke and preserved black fruit aromas; deep and concentrated with super fruit character and abundant tannin.

LEBANON

- 51. Château Musar, Bekaa Valley 1999** 34.95
Medium to full-bodied, high in alcohol, develops superb perfume and flavour with 7 to 10 years age – cedar, dried fruits, tobacco, coffee, raisin, chocolate.

SPAIN

- 52. Vina Salceda Crianza, Rioja 2003** 22.95
Dark ruby, pronounced damson fruits with peppery undertones. Dense rich blackberry with well-balanced acidity and tannins.

- 53. El Puig, Cellers Fuentes, Catalonia 2002** 42.50
Deep, almost opaque, precious red colour. Well balanced with delicate tannins and well integrated oak. Hints of liquorice, wild herbs and minerals and a persistent, aromatic finish.

ITALY

- 54. Barolo La Serre Macarini 1996** 49.95
This classic Barolo from the single 'La Morra' vineyard is fresh, elegant and very persistent on the nose, with hints of violet, rose, liquorice and sweet spices. Long and intense flavour.

55. Tignanello, Tuscany 2003 69.95
Fine oak character married to intense small-berried fruit. Powerful, stylish and long lived.

56. Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Taverna Nova 2005 18.95
Ripe, supple, peppery fruit with good concentration and depth.

57. Chianti Riserva Cantine di Montalcino 2001 28.95
Rich ruby colour with a distinctly fruity nose where cherry merges with vanilla. On the palate there is a good balance between fruit and tannins that creates a long finish.

58. Crognolo, Tuscany 2002 37.95
Tremendous depth and concentration. Complex combination of fresh and conserved red fruit aromas and spice. Fine balance of tannin and acidity with good depth.

FRANCE, BEAUJOLAIS

59. Beaujolais Villages Georges Duboeuf 2004 22.95
Brilliantly coloured with a penetrating berry fruit perfume and fine fruitiness. Fresh and easy to drink.

60. Brouilly, Chateau de Nerners Georges Duboeuf 2005 26.95
Wild strawberry fruit, peppery, full and smooth, with soft tannins and a slight greenness to flavour.

61. Morgon Côte Du Py Jean Marc Burgaud 2004 22.95
Powerful, dark, and quite mineral in character, this is typical Morgon Côte du Py. Restrained aromas of cherry and kirsch, loads of cherry and blackcurrant fruit and firm structure with ample tannins.

BURGUNDY

62. Nuits St George, Domaine Jean Chauvenet 2002 49.95
Complex with deep flavour. This is an outstanding wine showing elegance and refinement.

63. Givry, Louis Latour 2005 27.95
Rich, fruit driven bouquet with notes of wild cherry and raspberry that ends on a smooth fruit note.

64. Beaune Premier Cru, Les Bressandes, Jean Claude Boisset 2005 55.95
Leafy, earthy autumn fruit on the nose. Rich refined blackfruit and red cherry flavours with pronounced minerality and a hint of chocolate.

65. Cote de Beaune Villages, Maison Champy 2002 24.95
Soft fruit aromas with supple textures and rich flavours of Pinot Noir. Good fruit ripeness on the palate, clean and ripe with good acidity.

FRANCE, BORDEAUX

PAUILLAC

66. Château Mouton Rothschild Premier Cru 1988 189.00
A very good vintage the '88s are just coming into their prime. Still full structured, with great colour and flavours and powerful aromas of cassis and cedar, topped off with Mouton's trademark aromatic quality.

MARGAUX

67. Château d'Angludet 1996 56.95
A very good vintage showing rich, dense and powerful plum and red berry fruit with genuine quality and character.

SAINT EMILION

68. Château Franc Boudron 2002 19.95
Crammed with dark berry flavours and spicy currant fruit with genuine quality and character.

69. Château Pinfleures Grand Cru 2001 39.95
A consistently rich, fragrant and elegant wine with a great deal of character and complexity. Well balanced with a bouquet marked by red fruit flavours.

POMEROL

70. La Fleur Pomeaux 1999 59.95
The second wine from Château Pomeaux. Soft berries on the nose with a hint of dark cherry and silky smooth tannins. A pleasurable medium weight wine with a lingering finish.

SAINT JULIEN

- 71. Château Talbot 1995** 76.95
Consistent, full in fruit weight and flavour and superbly perfumed. Firmly structured developing great refinement and harmony with age.

FRANCE, LANGUEDOC

- 72. Mas de Daumas Gassac Rouge 2004** 64.95
Rich earthy black fruit, black cherries and chocolaty undertones it's big, powerful and refined with immense complexity and depth.

FRANCE, RHONE VALLEY

- 73. Cotes du Rhône Domaine St Estève 2004** 22.95
A medium-bodied wine, lively and fresh, with a spicy, aromatic nose and complex flavours of blackberry, black cherry and a hint of liquorice. Mainly Grenache, it has an elegant balance, and is round and flavoursome.

- 74. Gigondas Domaine Grand Romane 2003** 29.95
Characterful, robust, full-bodied with earthy, peppery, berried fruit, even leathery and gamey; warm and generous.

- 75. Crozes Hermitage Phillippe Desmeure 2004** 23.95
Dark, intense aromas of blackfruits and peppery spice, with a lovely big taste of blackberries and vanilla.

- 76. Châteauneuf du Pape Vieilles Vignes
Domaine La Milliere 2004** 31.95
Stunning wine with a deep rich character of dark fruit and liquorice, and a touch of black pepper. It's full bodied with masses of spiced fruit flavours, a firm grip and huge finish

DESSERT WINE

- 77. Château du Levants Sauternes 1998** 50cl 49.95
Full of butterscotch, honey and citrus fruit with a fantastic freshness to set off the sweetness.
- 78. Château d'Yquem Premier Grand Cru Classe 1991** 119.95
Tremendously rich, very honeyed, botrytized, complex bouquet and flavour. Very luscious and deep with supreme elegance.
- 79. Maury Vin Doux Naturele 2005** 75cl 34.95
Rich, deep velvety showing some acidity. A fine accompaniment to chocolate desserts.
- 80. Chateau Megyer Tokaji, Hungary 2000** 50cl 27.95
Rich, complex, apricotty flavour, sweet and showing some oxidized character. Plenty of acidity.
- 81. Lang Samling 88 Beerenauslese, Austria 2003** 33.75
A profound nose of honey, nuts, flowers, intoxicating in its richness. This is an outstanding dessert wine, a must try.
- 82. Brown Brothers Orange Flora Muscat, Victoria 2006** 21.75
Delightfully light packed with sweet, soft lingering orange tones.
- 83. Stanton & Kileen Rutherglen Muscat, Australia** 21.75
Honeyed, dark and sticky. Rich and complex in flavour, lightly perfumed with a long finish.
